Results of previous missions

- **A 1.3 – Develop and assist the HMR office of the Government to train trainers and implement training programs for civil servants from relevant institutions involved in the process of reporting and monitoring of regional conventions on minority rights**

The Activity Report on the methodology for monitoring the implementation of the Action Plan for National Minorities was developed by the STEs Mihaela Brezar and Maja Mamlić. The draft was sent to the Department Promoting the Rights of National Minorities, the feedback has been collected and the final version of the report translated into Serbian and submitted to the Department, to Biserka Terzić, Vladimir Šoć and Olga Radosavljević.

- **A 1.4 – Analyse the organisational and functional capacity of the Republic of Serbia to collect and disseminate disaggregated statistical data in the field of human rights and protection of minorities**

STEs, Maja Mamlić and Tatjana Vlašić still working on the Activity Report, which will then be shared with the Department Promoting the Rights of National Minorities, interim results have already been shared with the Department.

- **A 3.1 – Perform review of needs in relation to the legislation and practice in the area of protection of human rights defenders and minority protection in Serbia and propose recommendations**
